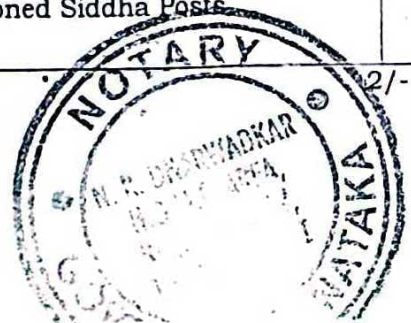

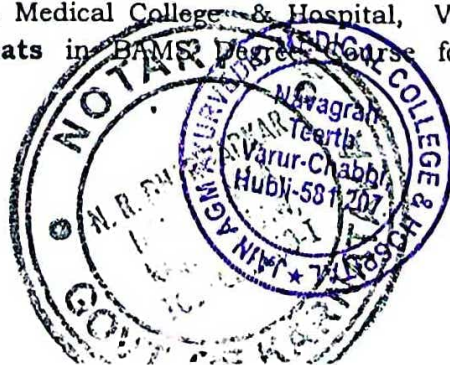

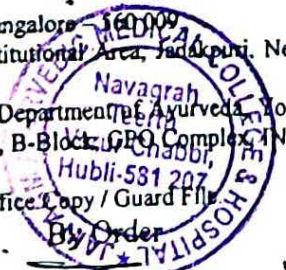

In continuation to this Ministry's letter of even No. dated 16.05.2017 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to you to establish a new Ayurveda college in the name of Jain AGM Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital, AT/Post Navagrahateertha Varur, NH-4 Road, Hubli (T), Dharward (D), Varur – 581 207, Karnataka with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations & report of the CCIM in terms of criteria as specified in the Regulations 3 and 10 of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, observations of Hearing Committees based on the submission made by college representatives during hearings and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC), Ministry of AYUSH for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2017-18 vide Ministry's letters No.R.11011/03/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 12.06.2017; permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the President, Swasti Shri 105 Dharmasen Bhattarak Pattacharya Mahaswami Dijambar Jain Amminabhavi Shakamutt, AT/Post Navagrahateertha Varur, NH-4 Road, Hubli (T),

2. The college may take admissions for 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2017-18 subject to the condition that the following requirements should be fulfilled by the college positively by the 31st December, 2017 to get conditional permission for the session 2018-19 (a copy of Assessment sheet of CCIM is also enclosed):

- (i) All the requirements under relevant provisions of the Minimum Standards Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 and Regulation 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, by 31st December, 2017 to get conditional permission for the session 2018-19;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.

3. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1st professional of BAMS course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.


4. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for IInd, IIIrd and IVth professionals well in time as per the CCIM norms which will be verified and reported by the CCIM at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.

5. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.

3. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate of the permitted intake capacity of 60 UG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the said Counseling Authority to admit students as per their rules, reservation policies norms. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCIM and the Central Government.
6. The following requirements must be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2019 to get permission for the session 2020-21:
- all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016.
 - all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
 - all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*
7. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2020-21.

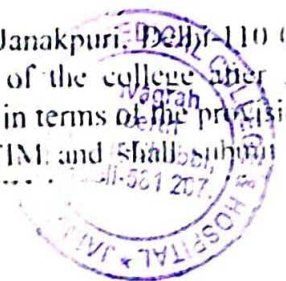

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No.R.12011/60/2016-EP (IM-1) dated-26.09.2017 related to admission matter for the year 2017-18 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2018-19.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 28.02.2018 and re-visited on 21-22.05.2018 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that the At least one specialist doctor or one clinical teacher in each of Kayachikitsa, Panchkarma, Shalya, Shalakya, Prasuti Tantra evam Stri Roga, Kaumarbharitya, Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff, Web based computerized central registration system, Functional X-ray, ECG and USG unit, Quality Testing Laboratory and College website as per RMS, 2016, were not available. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-

section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 17.08.2018 to present the case.

3. The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) it is found that College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting conditional permission for UG (BAMS) course.

4. It has been decided by the Central Government for *grant of conditional permission to the Jain AGM Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital, AT/Post- Navagarahateertha Varur, NH-4 Road, Tq. Dharward - 581207, Karnataka with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course* for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 *subject to the condition that college shall fulfill the deficiencies as mentioned below by 31st December, 2018:*

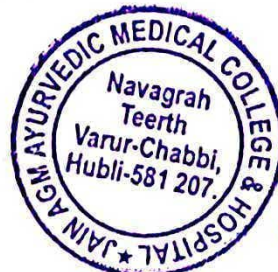
- (i) Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff as per RMS, 2016.
