
















INTRODUCTION





BAMS STRUCTURE

Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery (BAMS) is a comprehensive undergraduate program that combines the study of Ayurveda, and the structure of BAMS studies typically involves:

Course Duration: Total - 5 & half years

4 & 1/2 years of Study and 1 year (365 days) of mandatory, rotational internship.

1st BAMS - 1 & half years

2nd BAMS - 1 & half years

3rd BAMS - 1 & half years

What is taught:

- Pre-Clinical Subjects: These subjects cover the foundational sciences such as Anatomy, Physiology, and Biochemistry, providing students with a strong understanding of the human body's structure and functions.
- Para-Clinical Subjects: These include subjects like Pathology, Microbiology, Pharmacology, and Forensic Medicine. They provide insights into disease processes, diagnostics, drugs, and legal aspects of medicine.
- Clinical Subjects: This phase focuses on specialized areas like Medicine, Surgery, Gynecology and Obstetrics, Pediatrics, and more. Students learn about the diagnosis, treatment, and management of various health conditions.
- Internship: A mandatory internship period allows students to gain practical experience in clinical settings, putting their theoretical knowledge into practice.

Eligibility criteria for admission to a BAMS:

- Educational Qualifications: Candidates must have completed their 10+2 (or equivalent) education with Physics, Chemistry, Biology
- Minimum Marks: Candidates should have obtained a minimum 50% in their 10+2 examinations in Physics, Chemistry and Biology
- 3. **Entrance Exams:** NEET (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test) is mandatory for admission to BAMS programs. Eligibility criteria is announced and in Karnataka state, the KEA is responsible for conducting the counseling rounds for admission into BAMS in various colleges under different categories as prescribed by the authorities.
